Various options for publishing papers presented at the International Conference IFCS-2009 in Dresden/Germany

Papers presented at the conference IFCS-2009 in Dresden (March 13-18, 2009) can be published in two ways:

- by submitting a manuscript for the Proceedings volume that will be published in (post-proceedings). the end of 2009 Manuscripts (not more than 10 pages) must be sent electronically to the conference organizers after the conference and will have to pass a refereeing process before publication. For submission, deadline, and any details see the conference website www.ifcs2009.de
- by submitting them to one of the journals 'Advances in Data Analysis and Classification' (ADAC) and 'Journal of Classification' (JoC) that will both publish a Special Issue in 2009 for excellent papers from the conference. Submissions will undergo a peer reviewing process.

Original papers as well as substantially extended versions of an IFCS Proceedings article are welcome for these Special Issues. Submissions should be sent by electronic mail to EditorADAC@stochastik.rwth-aachen.de in the case of ADAC; for JoC manuscripts must by provided by the electronic submission system at <u>http://www.editorialmanager.com/clas/</u>.

Manuscripts should be sent after the conference, but before April 30, 2009.
